With Love from Salisbury House

Des Moines, IA (January 24, 2013) —Salisbury House & Gardens (SH&G) is pleased to announce a "one night only" performance of the Pulitzer Prize winning romantic comedy, *Love Letters*, in the intimate setting of Salisbury House's Common Room. Doors will open at 6:45 pm on Thursday, February 14<sup>th</sup> for a wine reception. The play will begin at 7:30 pm and will be performed by Repertory Theater of Iowa (RTI).

Prior to the performance, Salisbury House will restore Joseph Stella's 1925 oil painting "The Birth of Venus" to its place of honor in the Great Hall. This coveted painting from the Salisbury collection has been on loan to The Brooklyn Museum for its traveling exhibit, Youth & Beauty: Art of the American Twenties, and has been featured in some of America's finest museums this past year.

All proceeds from *Love Letters* will benefit of the 2013 production of *Shakespeare on the Lawn at Salisbury House* when *A Midsummer Night's Dream* will be presented in partnership between SH&G and RTI from June 20<sup>th</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup>, 2013.

Tickets for *Love Letters* are \$40 for adults, \$36 for SH&G members and \$25 for students. Seating is limited for this performance and advance ticket purchases are encouraged at www.salisburyhouse.org or (515) 274-1777.
